The Google Classroom App is provided via Google Apps for Education and is used by many school districts worldwide and represents an important step in digital learning and teaching 21st century skills to all students.

Each student has been provided with a Google Apps account, which includes email.

The safety of our students is vital to us, which is why we are partnered with Google's G Suite for Education. The email accounts that have been issued to students restrict them from emailing anyone EXCEPT for teachers and staff at The Lowell School. Students do not have the ability to send/receive emails to or from each other, or anyone else outside of the school domain.

If you are interested in seeing what we are working on in Google Classroom, your child can access the Classroom from home with their school login and password. Students can login from a web browser or use the free Google Classroom app available for Android, or IOS mobile devices.

In addition to learning and practicing important content with Google Classroom assignments, students will also be developing important computer skills.
